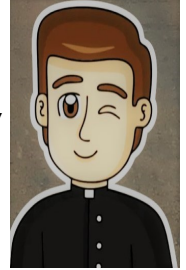

Dear friends in Christ, Today, the liturgy offers us an early scent of Easter joy. The celebrant's vestments are rose-colored. It is "Laetare Sunday," inviting us to a serene joy. "Rejoice with Jerusalem and be glad because of her, all you who love her..." sings the entrance antiphon. God wants us to be happy. The most basic psychology tells us that a person who does not live happily eventually becomes ill, both in body and spirit. However, our joy must be well-founded, it must be the expression of the serenity of living a life with full meaning.



Teaching of the Pastor: "Almsgiving during Lent"

"When you give alms, let your left not know what your right is doing." (Mt 6, 2-3)

Christians call it "alms" when we share our goods with the poorest. It should not be a contribution of what is left over but an act of love made from the heart, a sharing that moves us to renunciation and sacrifice. Everything comes from God as a gift. Our whole life must become a gift of love in imitation of Christ. But not only material, pecuniary alms: a few coins that we give to a poor beggar on the corner. Almsgiving has to go further: providing help to those who need it, teaching those who do not know, giving good advice to those who ask us for it, sharing joy, spreading a smile, offering our forgiveness to those who have offended us. Almsgiving is that willingness to share everything, the readiness to give to oneself. It means the attitude of openness and charity towards others.

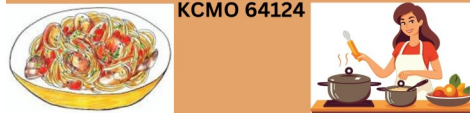

Queridos amigos en Cristo: Hoy, la liturgia nos ofrece un aroma anticipado de la alegría pascual.

Los ornamentos del celebrante son rosados. Es el domingo "laetare" que nos invita a una serena alegría.

«Festejad a Jerusalén, gozad con ella todos los que la amáis...», canta la antifona de entrada. Dios quiere que estemos contentos. La psicología más elemental nos dice que una persona que no vive contenta acaba enferma, de cuerpo y de espíritu. Ahora bien, nuestra alegría ha de estar bien fundamentada, ha de ser la expresión de la serenidad de vivir una vida con sentido pleno.

La Enseñanza del Párroco: "La Limosna en la Cuaresma",

«Cuando des limosna, no sepa tu izquierda lo que hace tu derecha» (Mt 6, 2-3)

Los cristianos llamamos "limosna" al compartir con los más pobres nuestros bienes. No debe ser un aporte de lo que sobra sino un acto de amor hecho de corazón, un compartir que nos mueve a renuncia y al sacrificio. Todo viene de Dios como don. Toda nuestra vida debe convertirse en una dádiva de amor en imitación a Cristo. Pero no sólo la limosna material, pecuniaria: unas cuantas monedas que damos a un pobre mendigo en la esquina. La limosna tiene que ir más allá: prestar ayuda a quien necesita, enseñar al que no sabe, dar buen consejo al que nos lo pide, compartir alegrías, repartir sonrisa, ofrecer nuestro perdón a quien nos ha ofendido. La limosna es esa disponibilidad a compartir todo, la prontitud a darse a sí mismos. Significa la actitud de apertura y la caridad hacia el otro.
