Teaching of the Pastor: "Easter Sunday"

It is the most important holiday for Catholics. Christ triumphs over death, in this way, he opens the doors of heaven to each of us. He gives us redemption and deliverance from the sin of humanity. When we celebrate his resurrection, we celebrate the defeat of sin and death. Death does not have the last word since Jesus defeated it.

Therefore, we know that we, too, will be resurrected; In this way our whole life acquires meaning. In the celebration of mass, the Easter candle is lit, which symbolizes the risen Christ, light of all people. Thus begins a period known as Easter Time, a time in which Jesus remained with the apostles, before ascending to heaven. Concluding after 50 days, on Pentecost Sunday.

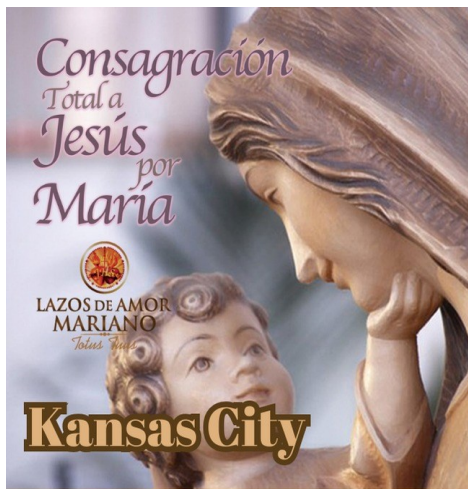

Queridos amigos en Cristo: Hoy «es el día que hizo el Señor», iremos cantando a lo largo de toda la Pascua. Y es que esta expresión del Salmo 117 inunda la celebración de la fe cristiana. El Padre ha resucitado a su Hijo Jesucristo, el Amado, Aquél en quien se complace porque ha amado hasta dar su vida por todos. Vivamos la Pascua con mucha alegría. Cristo ha resucitado: celebrémoslo llenos de alegría y de amor. Hoy, Jesucristo ha vencido a la muerte, al pecado, a la tristeza... y nos ha abierto las puertas de la nueva vida, la auténtica vida, la que el Espíritu Santo va dándonos por pura gracia. ¡Que nadie esté triste! Cristo es nuestra Paz y nuestro Camino para siempre.

La Enseñanza del Párroco: “Domingo de Resurrección”

Es la fiesta más importante para los católicos. Cristo triunfa sobre la muerte, de este modo, nos abre las puertas del cielo a cada uno de nosotros. Nos da la redención y liberación del pecado de la humanidad. Cuando celebramos su resurrección, celebramos la derrota del pecado y de la muerte. La muerte no tiene la última palabra ya que Jesús la venció.

Por ello, sabemos que nosotros también, resucitaremos; de esta manera toda nuestra vida adquiere sentido. En la celebración de la misa, se enciende el cirio pascual, que simboliza a Cristo resucitado, luz de todas las gentes. Se inicia así un periodo conocido como Tiempo Pascual, tiempo en el que Jesús permaneció con los apóstoles, antes de subir al cielo. Concluyendo a los 50 días, en el Domingo de Pentecostés.
