Shepherd's Voice:



Laetare Sunday is celebrated on the Fourth Sunday of Lent and serves as a joyful pause in the midst of the penitential season. The word *Laetare* comes from the Latin for “rejoice,” taken from the entrance antiphon *Laetare Jerusalem* (“Rejoice, O Jerusalem”). In the middle of Lent, when the Church calls us to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, this Sunday reminds us that Easter is drawing closer and invites us to rejoice in the hope of Christ’s Resurrection.

The Church has celebrated *Laetare Sunday* for many centuries, with its origins found in the early medieval Roman liturgy. This tradition developed to strengthen the faithful as they continued their journey toward the celebration of Easter.

A distinctive feature of this Sunday is the use of **rose-colored vestments** instead of the usual violet of Lent. The lighter color symbolizes joy and hope breaking through the penitential tone of the season. *Laetare Sunday* occurs **three Sundays before Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday**, marking that the Church is now more than halfway through the Lenten journey and drawing nearer to the sacred celebrations of Christ’s Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

Please continue to join us for **Stations of the Cross every Friday of Lent at 7:00 PM**, and for **our Fish Fry Taco Dinner each Friday from 5:00–7:00 PM**. We look forward to sharing this meaningful season with you.



La Voz del Pastor:

El Domingo de Laetare se celebra en el Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma y representa una pausa de alegría en medio del tiempo penitencial. La palabra Laetare proviene del latín y significa "alégrate", tomada de la antífona de entrada Laetare Jerusalén ("Alégrate, Jerusalén"). En medio de la Cuaresma, cuando la Iglesia nos llama a la oración, el ayuno y la limosna, este domingo nos recuerda que la Pascua está cada vez más cerca y nos invita a alegrarnos en la esperanza de la Resurrección de Cristo.

La Iglesia celebra el Domingo de Laetare desde hace muchos siglos. En algunos lugares también era conocido como el "Domingo de alivio" o "de descanso", porque antiguamente se suavizaban un poco las prácticas estrictas del ayuno cuaresmal.

Un signo particular de este domingo en la liturgia es el uso del **color rosa en las vestiduras**, en lugar del color morado habitual de la Cuaresma. Este color simboliza la alegría y la esperanza que comienzan a brillar mientras nos acercamos a la Pascua. El Domingo de Laetare se celebra **tres domingos antes de que comience la Semana Santa con el Domingo de Ramos**, recordándonos que el camino cuaresmal está ya más de la mitad recorrido.

Continuo invitando a acompañarnos en el Vía Crucis todos los viernes de Cuaresma a las 7:00 p.m., y a nuestra Cena de Tacos de Pescado cada viernes de 5:00 a 7:00 p.m. Esperamos compartir juntos este tiempo de gracia.
